- Add -> Existing Item

  - Product & Site Images
- Add -> New Item & Copy/Paste
  - Master Page
  - Client Pages
- Edit Image/Css links if necessary

## Copy <Section id="login">

- From Site.Master to MainSite.Master
- Add New MS\_Styles.css
- Copy Login Styles to MS\_Styles.css
- Link in MS\_Styles
- Add float:right; to #login
- Add float:left to header section{}
- Adjust colours
