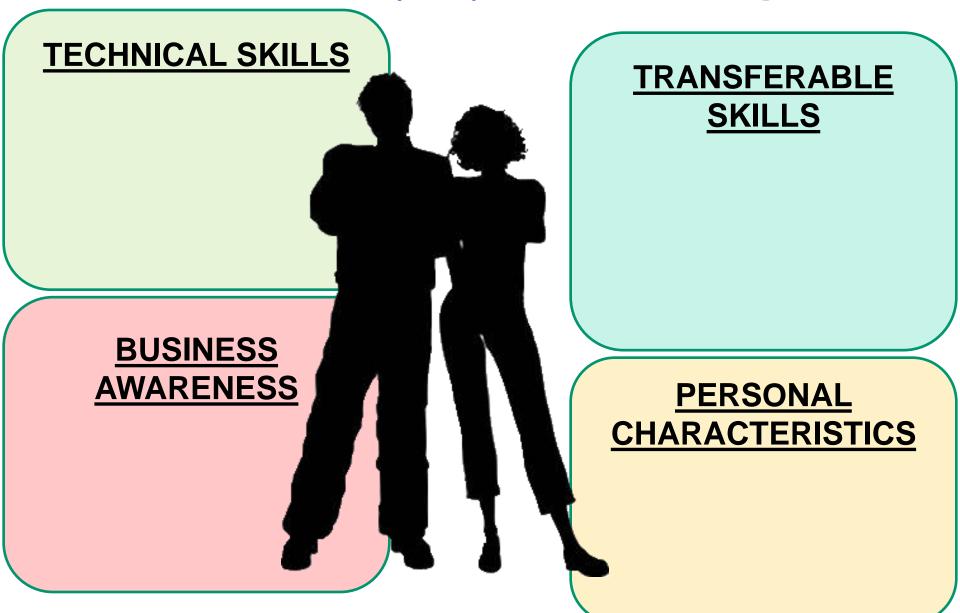

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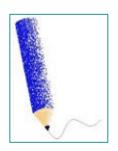

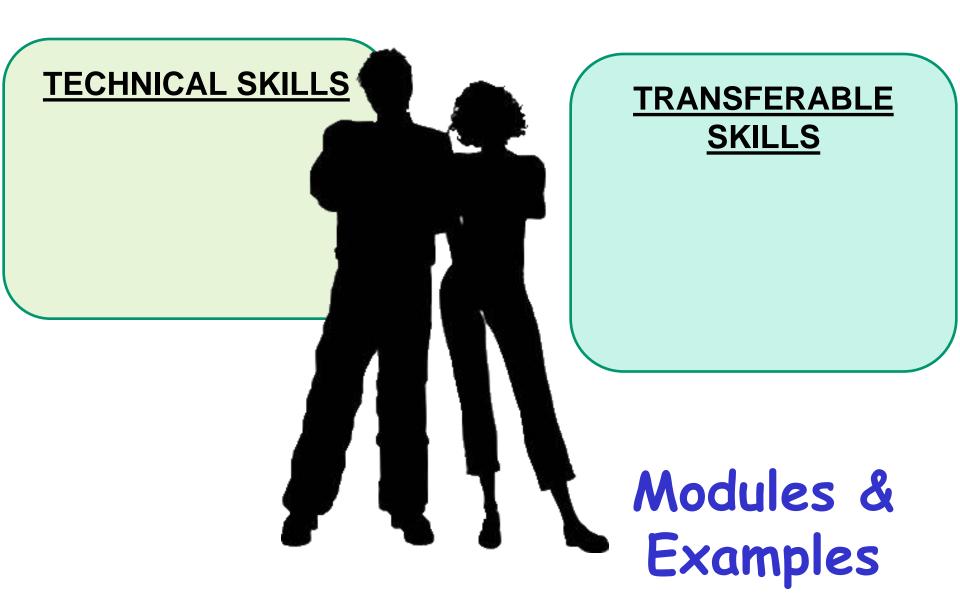

## **Work-Related Project**

 This module focuses upon the personal and professional development of the Student. Key project management skills will be developed, including research and investigative skills, problem solving and critical analysis.

## **Work-Related Project**

Meanwhile, the Student will be required to take a broader responsibility for their own development in different contexts, reflecting regularly about their learning and experiences. Students will be expected to compile a detailed reflective diary or portfolio (including a CV) that presents evidence of their development, as well as a project report alongside any related deliverables.
